



# CEDRIC'S CRAFT CORNER

## PAPER PLATE PUFFIN



### METHOD

Step 1: Begin by folding your paper plate in half. Create a 2cm slit along the crease, then fold the two sides up to form the tail. This will enable your puffin to stand upright.

Step 2: Use a black felt-tip pen or pencil to outline the puffin's head and body on both sides of the folded plate. Fill in these outlines with black paint or colour them in.

Step 3: On a piece of cardboard or cereal box, trace and cut out two feet and a beak shape. Paint or colour these pieces orange.

Step 4: Fold the paper plate back in half and glue the center together securely. Attach the cardboard beak between the two plates near the head, and affix the two cardboard feet to the bottom of the plate on each side of the tail.

By following these steps, you'll create a charming puffin craft that stands up nicely and showcases the distinctive features of this adorable bird!

### SUPPLIES

Paper plate

Cardboard

Glue

Black paint / pencils

Orange paint / pencils

Scissors
